Challenge Contest

Savvy Shopping Challenge: Purchase an outfit that represents the 4-H'ers intended use for the selected outfit.

- Outfits may be purchased at a retail store, garage sale, consignment store, or resale shop (i.e. Goodwill, Salvation Army, or other stores of this type.)
- Cost of outfit must be \$20 or less (not including shoes, accessories or undergarments)
- Receipt(s) and the buymanship form **MUST** be turned in with the Registration Guide.

Family Entry Process

Fashion Revue garments can be entered as a fashion revue entry as well as a clothing exhibit (constructed, sew and buy, or selected outfit) and on display in the county booths set up in Nordby Exhibit Hall.

Entries must be registered by August 20th in Fair Entry. No adjustments will be allowed after August 20th.

Families must register for Fashion Revue on Fair Entry and select a time. Please note that the time selected will be your assigned time. Please don't register more than 1 outfit/entry per time shift.

Dressing rooms are limited to bathrooms, for your convenience members exhibiting one outfit should come dressed, if possible.



The following registration guide MUST be submitted for each participant and each outfit entered in the State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue. No more than 2 outfits per lot may be exhibited.

Be sure to answer the question "What lifeskill have you gained through 4-H?" within the narrative. Narrations will be limited to 500 characters including spaces.

Narration examples:

Jane Doe of YYY County, models a colorful polka dot sundress to complement her bubbly and fun personality. The circle skirt falls in graceful folds and the fitted bodice has spaghetti straps. This was Jane's first attempt at putting in a zipper. Participating in Fashion Revue has given her confidence to walk and talk with poise. Jane will be a senior at ZZZ this fall.

Here comes MMM County 4-H'er, John Doe, in his blast from the past suit. The outfit features a vintage jacket and matching slacks perfect for senior prom.
