



However, to continue recruiting participants to the same conference, we once recruited teens to in the 80's, is indeed the definition of insanity. Young people have changed and evolved. Therefore, this year a special rebrand committee comprised of Teen Leadership Conference planning committee members and their advisors was formed to evaluate how we can better market to teens of the 21st century. However, we are making ourselves more attractive to our target audience.

Without further ado, we present to you SkillsX by 4-H (formally Teen Leadership Conference). SkillsX by 4-H provides all teens with an opportunity to develop their leadership and life skills, while working to learn, grow, and express themselves through an educational on-campus experience. The concept behind the new name is that our conference focuses deeply on skill development, whether that be leadership skills, soft-skills or career and industry specific skills.
